

Sample Booth Layouts for 2010 Melrose Art Festival

- You may be assigned to a booth that is a mirror image of these or slightly different shape.
- The three vertical panels are expected to contain the bulk of your work.
- Small shelves, tables or bins may be used for items like business cards, reproductions, or a notebook of additional work, although we caution using up too much floor space. People like to get out of the flow of traffic to look at your work.
- Any additional furniture may not extend beyond the dashed line (approx. 24 sq ft.). This is to allow adequate circulation space for the public. The chair (optional, supplied by MACA) must also fit within this space.
- Access to any bins or tables must be from your booth space and not your neighbor's.
- MACA reserves the right to remove any furniture that constricts traffic flow or does not conform to the limitations listed.
